Winter recreational programs are back in full-swing here at HHGC! And our coaching team is so excited to take on another fantastic session filled with the Fun, Fitness, and Fundamentals of gymnastics, with all of our new and returning athletes! It has only been a few weeks, but we are already seeing lots of new skills, and big improvements from our athletes, and cannot wait to see where this session will take them!

We have so much going on at HHGC in the next few weeks so here are a few important dates to remember:

Registration for our upcoming Spring Recreational session (Saturday March 15th to Friday May 16th) will open at 12:00 AM on Monday, February 10th! We are expecting classes to fill up very quickly so please register early as you don't want to miss out!! The class options are all currently posted for "viewing purposes" on the HHGC website and in the Parent Portal!

Recreational athletes in the following programs: Kindergym, Advanced Kindergym, Aspire, Girls Gym, Intermediate Girls Gym, Sr. Girls Gym, Sr. Intermediate Girls Gym, Boys Gym, and all Tumbling and Trampoline classes, will have received a progress report after their class during the week of January 25th-31st. These progress reports will have important information about what class we recommend the athletes are registered for in the spring session, so please review them carefully before registering your athlete for the spring session to make sure your athlete is placed in the correct class! Please note that if your athlete is participating in a Tumbling class there were changes made to the breakdown of skills within the Tumbling Levels during the Fall 2024 session that may impact the level/class (not specific skills) that they may be working on or recommended to, if you have questions about these changes please contact Emily directly!

Registration for HHGC Summer Camps will also be opening at 12:00 AM on Monday, February 10th! We will be running 8 weeks of summer camp programs with many exciting themes, activities, special guests, and much, much more! Summer Camp is open to anyone between 4 and 12 years old, no experience required! And new this year will be offering full-day camps for all age groups, Kinder Gymnastics Camp will also be offered as a half-day option for those younger campers who aren't quite ready for full-day camp!

HHGC is excited to announce that for the first time (in many years) we will be running a March Break Camp for anyone between the ages of 4 and 12 years old, no experience needed! Spaces are still open but are very limited, so don't delay in registering for this exciting week of gymnastics, games, activities, crafts and more! Registration is currently up and open on the HHGC website and through the Parent Portal!

This session HHGC will be closed on Monday February 17th (Family Day), Monday classes have already been prorated to account for this missed class.

This February, HHGC will be walking in the **Coldest Night of the Year** - a winter fundraiser for people in our community who need our support.

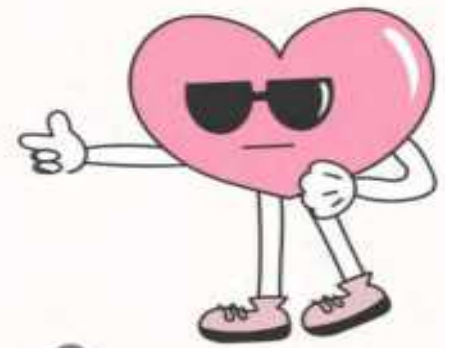
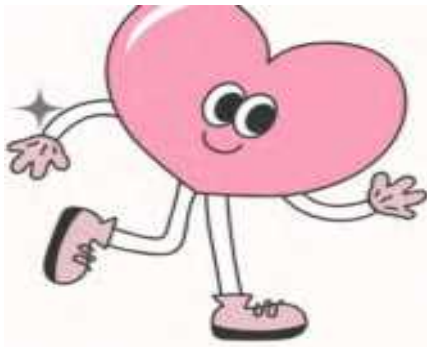
HHGC's team will be walking for maybe an hour or two at most - a little walk, really - but it's a big deal for the people we're supporting. Would you support our walk with a personal donation?

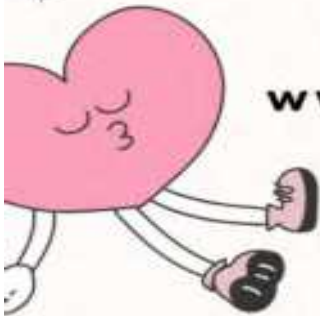
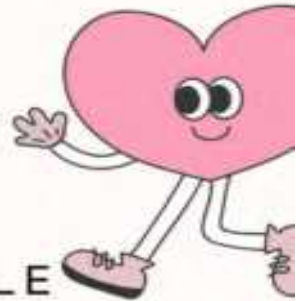
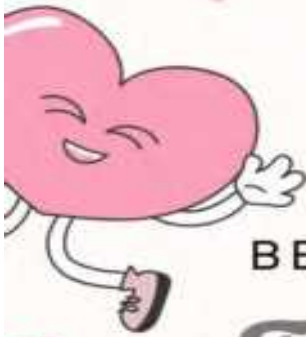

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FACILITY UPGRADE COMING THIS SPRING

HHGC has been awarded a capital grant from the Provincial Government's Ontario Trillium Foundation. We are planning a major facility upgrade in the coming months worth over \$100,000, pending permitting approval from the Town of Halton Hills.

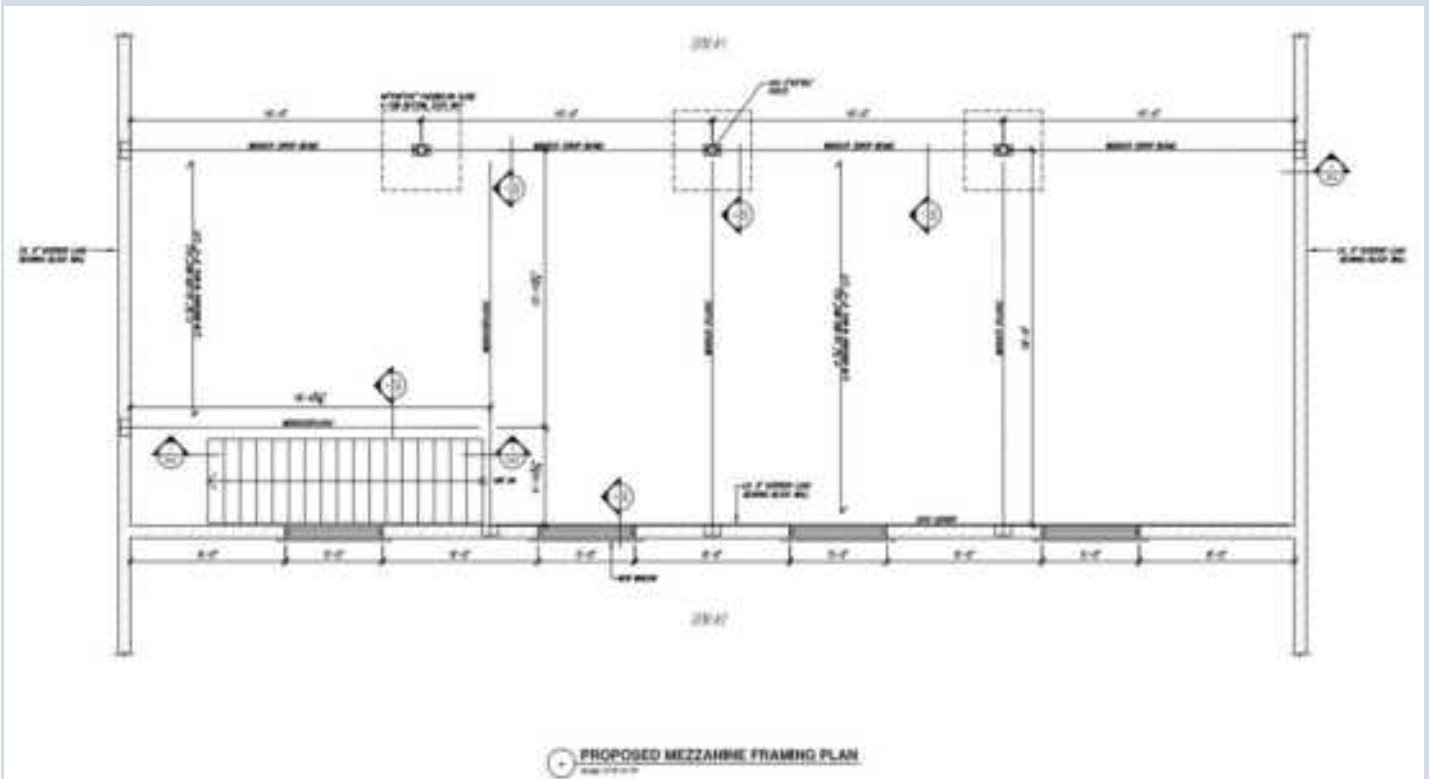
It will entail a second story mezzanine - constructed above the current viewing room and locker room(s). The mezzanine will house more spacious and comfortable viewing, as well as a private party room, plus additional storage for the facility. The main floor viewing will be repurposed as accessible viewing, for members with strollers or accessibility issues. The renovation is planned for May 20 – June 30, 2025 and we will do our best to ensure this renovation does not impact activity at HHGC.
